Your involvement and support through the purchase of a Farm Share or Nash Bucks further develops your understanding of how our food is produced and reconnects you to the exquisite Dungeness Delta.

Nash's Farm Share Program... beneficial to both you and the farmer.

### You will receive:

- 20 weekly shares from July to November. Each box is filled with seasonal vegetables, herbs, flour, grains and fruits. We harvest everything in its prime ensuring that you get the freshest and most vitamin/nutrient-rich produce possible.
- A weekly newsletter with recipes, storage and health tips, news from the farm, and information about agricultural issues.
- An increased awareness both about agriculture on the Peninsula and the importance of community support for your local farmers.

### The farmer receives:

- Your financial commitment at critical times in the growing season, to help fund seed purchases, equipment, supplies, and employees necessary for planting, cultivating, and harvesting.
- A personal connection with the community and the folks we are feeding.
- Financial security that allows us to continue as stewards of the Dungeness Delta.

**Share the Harvest.** A regular Farm Share should provide the foundation to feed a family of 2 to 4 people. As the season progresses and crop diversity changes, the farm's bounty is reflected in your Share. Running from July to November, the farm share program provides you and your family with twenty weeks of delicious produce!

**Share the Adventure.** Farming can be a risk. Nash calls it an adventure! He plants a diverse selection of varieties and crops, among them, his famous carrots—the sweetest and most tender in the Northwest. A standard-sized Farm Share box contains 9 to 12 different items, ranging from leafy greens and delicate peas to savory squash and hearty root vegetables. The small box contains 5 to 7 items. Subscribe and enjoy the luxury of tasting vegetables as you never have before! You may swap one veggie for an approved item each week.

**Meet Your Farmer.** Nash Huber was raised on a farm in southern Illinois. Since founding Nash's Organic Produce over 30 years ago, he has been working to provide a healthy organic food source for our community. Located on East Anderson Road, north of the Old Dungeness Schoolhouse in Clallam County, Nash's Organic Produce is Certified Organic by the Washington State Department of Agriculture.

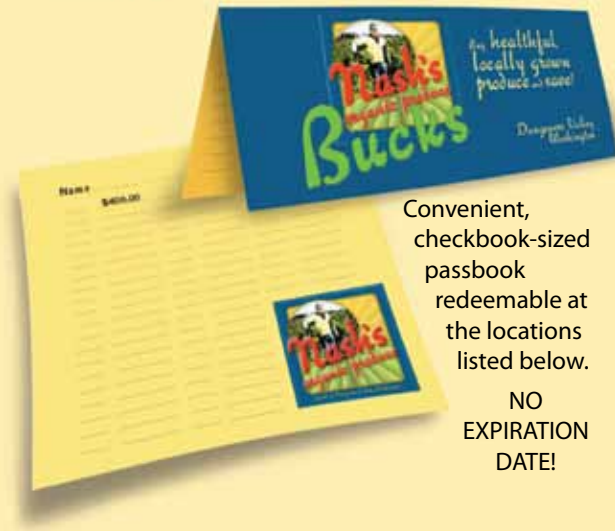
